### **Recipe – Absolutely Lush Chocolate Cake**

225g unsalted butter, softened  
225g caster sugar  
4 large free range eggs, beaten  
1 tsp vanilla extract  
200g self-raising flour  
½ tsp baking powder  
50g cocoa  
100g dark chocolate, melted

*For the Ganache:*  
200g dark chocolate  
100g milk chocolate  
250ml double cream

### **Method**

1. Preheat the oven to 180°C (160°C for a fan oven).
2. In a bowl of a free-standing mixer, cream the butter and sugar together until pale, light and fluffy. Gradually add the beaten eggs and vanilla extract. Add the flour, baking powder and cocoa then mix until combined. Add the melted chocolate and mix again until smooth.
3. Divide equally between the prepared sandwich tins, spread level and bake on the middle shelf of the preheated oven for about 22–25 minutes until golden and a skewer comes away clean when inserted into the middle of the cakes. Turn the cakes out of the tins onto a wire cooling rack and leave until cold.
4. *To make the ganache:* finely chop both the dark and milk chocolate and tip into a saucepan along with the double cream. Set the pan over a low heat to melt, stirring continuously until smooth. Pour the ganache into a shallow dish to cool and then chill. To assemble the cake, place one of the cakes on a cake or serving plate and spoon half of the ganache on the cake and spread.
5. Cover the top of the second cake layer with ganache, spreading it smoothly with a palette knife. Sandwich the two cakes together and decorate in a style suitable for the season or the event.
