87gms caster sugar  
2 eggs  
2 tablespoons lemon curd  
125gms self raising flour

2 tablespoons granulated sugar  
dissolved in juice of half a lemon

2lb loaf tin, greased and lined

### **Method**

Place all ingredients in a mixing bowl.

Beat until light and fluffy.

Spoon mixture into the loaf tin, place on the middle shelf of the oven.

When baked, immediately brush the cake with the topping syrup.

Remove cake from tin and cool on a wire tray until cold.
